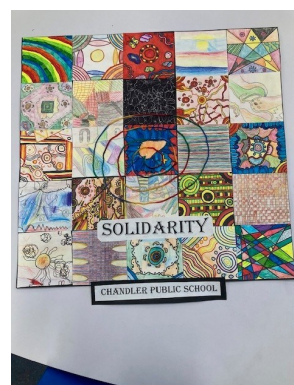

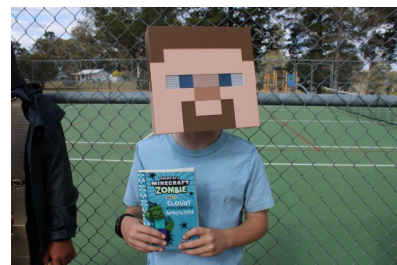
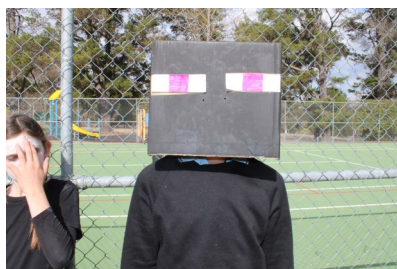
Super Student—

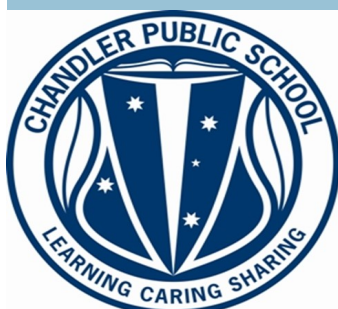
The menu was : Broccoli and Cauliflower Cheese Bake, Mini Quiches and Cheese and Spring Onion Muffins!
