Far Out Science!

On the 30th of October Stage 3 went to Far Out Science at the UNE ~ with Mr. Jones. Our first activity was Chemistry. In Chemistry scientists blew up balloons by putting different gases inside them. We watched experts use liquid nitrogen to freeze different objects including balloons, tennis balls and flowers. The flower smashed to pieces, the balloon shrunk and expanded again back to its normal size and the tennis ball didn't bounce.

Secondly, we studied chicken eggs. How they grow, what they are made out of and differences in each egg.


After we learned about eggs we did Palaeontology, we measured a sheep skull, fox skull and kangaroo skull. We used a special ruler to measure the skulls.

Next we did animal tracking, we used a radar to track a number of turtle shells that were hidden around the UNE grounds. We had to write down the location and description about where the turtle shell was found. We filled out a quiz where you could win a speaker, headphones, plasma ball or LEGO! Unfortunately none of us won any prizes.

We learned a lot and had a blast!!!


